- If you're not smiling, you're not doing it right.

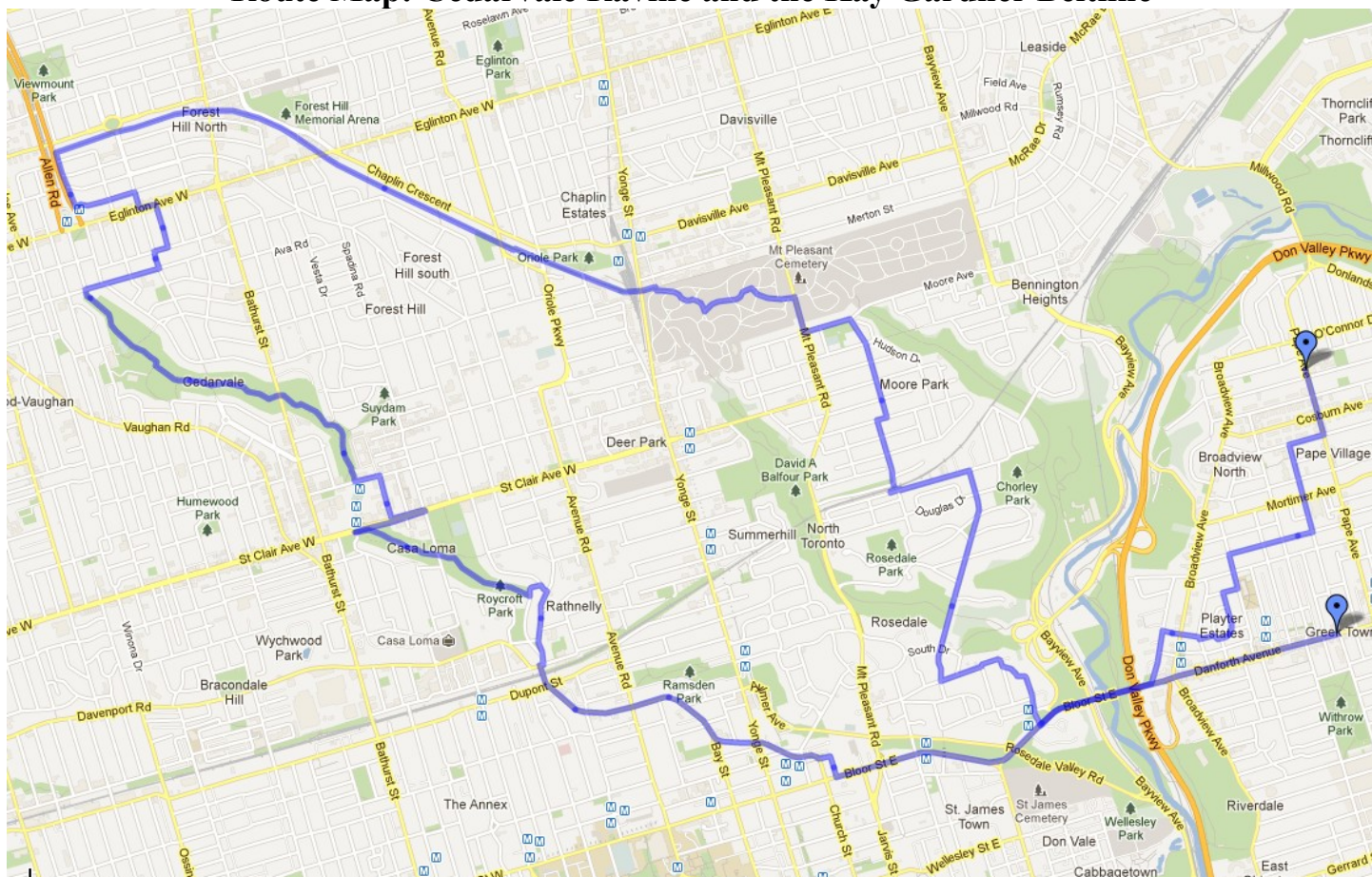

	Start south on Pape Ave. from Torrens	850 m
→	Fulton Ave.	700 m
←	Jackman Ave.	400 m
→	Playter Blvd. Turns into Pretoria Ave.	550 m
←	Cambridge Ave.	300 m
→	Danforth Ave. Continue onto Bloor St.	1.9 km
→	St. Paul's Sq.	200 m
→	Church St. Turns into Davenport; continue past Dupont	1.8 km
→	Poplar Plains Rd.	450 m
←	Russell Hill Rd.	50 m
←	Boulton Dr.	100 m
→	Roycroft Park	1 km
→	St. Clair Ave. West	300 m
←	Tweedsmuir Ave Dismount, cross as pedestrian	250 m
←	Heath St. West	150 m
→	Cedarvale Ravine Ride onto the path through the subway entrance	2.1 km
→	Ava Rd.	450 m

←	Glen Cedar Rd. Turns into Old Park Road north of Eglinton	450 m
←	Wembley Rd.	350 m
→	Allen Road pathway	300 m
→	Beltline Trail (see ride notes on reverse)	3.6 km
→	Mt. Pleasant Cemetery Follow blue line toward Visitor Centre	1.5 km
→	Moore Ave	75 m
←	Welland Ave.	600 m
←	Inglewood Dr.	50 m
←	Maclennan Ave	250 m
↘	Pedestrian bridge Bear right onto railway crossing	100 m
←	Summerhill Ave.	500 m
→	Glen Rd.	1.3 km
←	Maple Ave.	280 m
←	Dale Ave.	280 m
→	Castle Frank Rd.	150 m
←	Bloor St. East	1.8 km
	Ride ends at Danforth Ave. & Logan Ave.	

## Ride notes:

- There is some loose gravel on some ravine paths; use caution while riding.
- The Beltline is a soft surface trail. It's suitable for all kinds of bikes, but you may want to avoid sections up to 24 hours after rain.
- Where the Beltline crosses streets at grade, cyclists should dismount and cross at the nearest intersection.
- The gates of Mount Pleasant Cemetery close at 8 p.m. during the late spring and summer; if you are riding late, use an alternate route rather than going through the cemetery.
